RESOLUTION NO. 242503

A RESOLUTION OF THE CENTRAL VALLEY FIRE DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES REQUESTING THE COUNTY COMMISSION TO LEVY THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF MILLS ALLOWED BY STATE LAW 15-10-420 MCA.

WHEREAS, the Montana Legislature in HB 124 generally revised property tax laws and established procedure by which mill levies must be established in order to comply with tax limitations; and

WHEREAS, the Central Valley Fire District Board of Trustees requests that it receives tax revenue in Fiscal Year 2025 in an amount equal or greater than received in Fiscal Year 2024, plus revenue on newly taxable property, inclusive of the inflationary adjustment authorized by state law; **and the Fiscal Year 2025 revenue should be greater than all cash carryovers from Fiscal Year 2024;** and

WHEREAS, the 1999, 2001 and 2003 Legislature amended significant portions of state law affecting property taxes, motor vehicle revenues and other state distributed revenues that have resulted in major changes to the funding mechanisms of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Central Valley Fire District Board of Trustees has determined that the maximum number of mills allowed by state law is necessary to adequately fund the ongoing public health, safety and welfare duties and activities of the District; and


WHEREAS, a duly noticed public hearing was held on August 20, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:






